- **Volunteer runner**
 - You must have your Ontario Licence
 - Have access to a car
 - Will be in charge of transporting items needed throughout the day, to and from the office on Bayly Road
 - Packing up at the end of the night
 - Transporting items back to the office
 - Making sure the area is neat before we leave
- **Set up and take down crew**
 - Set up and take down tables, chairs, experiment tables etc. before guests arrive
- **Experiment hosts and helpers**
 - Conduct experiments for the kids
 - Help make the day an exciting and memorable experience for the girls
 - Help the hosts with getting supplies
 - Help with keeping everyone attention
 - Help the kids at the table with crafts and experiments
- **Community Liaison Crew**
 - Hand out flyers
 - Sign- up people for electronic newsletter
 - Educate parents on Girls Inc.
 - Sign- up people for monthly donations or sponsorship
