We need at least 8 volunteers on each day to be an effective team and to run the event smoothly. This a great way for high school students to gain 15 hours of volunteers service hours.

We are always looking for people to donate any utensils, batter mix, coffee, hot chocolate, cream or any other relevant

materials for this event.

Job Titles for this event:

- **Set-up Crew 8:15 – 10:00 a.m.**
 - Move food from parking lot to bottom of hill
 - Start coffee and hot chocolate
 - Set up cash and tickets
 - Set up drinks (water, juice, hot chocolate, cups, stir sticks, milk, creamers, sugar)
 - Start rolling forks and knives into napkins
 - Mixing of pancake batter
 - Post signage (Girls Inc. signs, thank you to sponsors, cost of extra syrup and drinks)
 - Set up Girls Inc. Jewelry table
 - Ensure garbage bins and bags are available
 - Ensure tables are clean and ready to go
 - Start cooking pancakes
 - Start sterno for warming pans

- **Serving Crew 10:00 – 2:30**
 - Cooks**
 - Measuring batter and flipping pancakes
 - Instructing volunteers when to mix more batter
 - Instructing staff of any needs
 - Please ensure to wear gloves if touching pancakes with hands

Ticket Sellers

- Count float at starting and end of day
- Sell tickets
- Hand out appropriate tickets

Servers

- Ensure that we have enough napkins, forks and knives prepared
- Ensure that we have butters and maple syrup ready to go
- Collect tickets from guest
- Serve pancakes from warmers and let cooks know when supplies are low

Continuous Clean Up Crew (this task will be assigned but it would be appreciated if everyone could help with this task)

- Watch garbage cans and ensure that we replace with clean bags when needed
- Wipe down trays and return to servers
- Wipe down tables
- Throw any visible garbage in bins

Drink Servers

- Serve hot chocolate, coffee, water, juice boxes as orders are placed
- Refill cream, milk, stir sticks, sugar, coffee and hot chocolate supply

Batter Mixers & Supply Refill

- Mix batter on stand provided
- Transporting batter to tent
- Ensure that coffee/hot chocolate does not run out

End of Day Clean Up

- Wash all bowls, pails, flippers, etc..
- Bring all supplies into the kitchen
- Gather all garbage into one pile
- Inventory Count
- Wipe down all table
- Ensure clean garbage bags are in bins
- Clean kitchen
